The Share family learning programme uses a practical approach to involving parents and carers in their children's learning, and to increasing parents' and carers' understanding of the vital role they play in their children's development.

Parents and carers of children at Foundation and Key Stage 1 are invited into the school or community setting for practical sessions with a Share facilitator/practitioner. Using Share materials, they then work at home with their children on activities linked to the national curriculum.

Our Share practitioner training course is aimed at people in schools or community settings who are keen to develop family learning – for example, teachers, classroom assistants, social workers, childminders and community development workers.

This one-day course is suitable for experienced facilitators, who have group work skills and are confident about running groups. It involves methodology, familiarisation of materials and ideas for recruitment.
