

# Community cohesion

## Training course

ContinYou has been working with others for many years to develop a greater understanding of community cohesion and look at the implications, particularly for schools and out-of-school-hours settings.

This new course will still focus on learning settings, but will also address the issue for those working in the community, health and other public sector settings, especially when working in conjunction with community partners.

We will look at the policy framework and address the implications for those working to make community cohesion work in practice.

Whether you are from the community sector, public sector or a school, this training will enable you to reflect on current practice, understand the context and plan actions to take back to your work setting.

You will be working with others who are trying to determine the best way of addressing this important issue.

The course will look at what policy makers mean by cohesion and integration and look at how workers can practically encourage cohesive communities.

The day-long course will be held in venues across England and will cost £195 per delegate.
