## Supporting Community Focused Schools Service

ContinYou Cymru provides this service, which is funded by the Welsh Assembly Government (WAG) to support local education authorities (LEAs), schools and key stakeholders in developing and delivering community focused schools (CFS) and out-of-school-hours learning (oshl) across the country.

## CânSing

This new project, funded by WAG, aims to raise the standard of singing in schools across Wales by extending opportunities and improving the quality of provision and delivery. CânSing also aims to improve the experience of pupils moving from primary to secondary school, and to make links with oshl and CFS developments. We are developing an innovative training programme and curriculum-linked resources, which will be useful for all those working at Key Stage 2.

## Funding and Resourcing Activities Outside the School Day

Do you want to find out more about funding, resourcing and sustaining oshl and CFS activities? This masterclass, delivered in partnership with Martin Price Associates, will offer you guidance on presenting your project to a funder and making successful applications.

## Engaging with Families

## Pyramid and Pyramid Club leadership courses

As well as running our very own Pyramid Cymru programme for shy and withdrawn pupils, we also offer extensive training for Pyramid club leaders.

Following our successful Cymru Cooks project, we now offer help and advice on setting up and sustaining cookery clubs for children, families and the community.

## OwnZone: a safe place to be

Do you want a framework that combines oshl activities, pastoral support and a 'safe place to be' for 11 to 16 year olds? We can help you establish a successful OwnZone club in your own setting.

## Volunteering for Active Communities (V4AC)

V4AC provides training and accreditation for adults volunteering in oshl and community focused schools activities.

## Managing Challenging Behaviour

Our training offers opportunities to develop a greater understanding of children and young people, as well as providing practical advice and strategies for addressing challenging behaviour.

## Involving Men as Fathers

We offer interactive seminars that aim to increase awareness of the issues around involving men in their children's learning.

## Smooth Moves

Smooth Moves is designed to help parents/carers who struggle to support their child as they move from one school to another. Our training session will give you everything you need to enable you to provide this programme to help your parents/carers.

## Breakfast Clubs

We can help you to set up successful breakfast clubs – not only for children and young people, but also for families and the wider community.

## Growing Their Self-esteem

Self-esteem helps children and young people succeed in all aspects of life. This course provides everything you need to run the Growing Their Self-esteem programme, which offers practical help and advice to parents/carers on raising their child's self-esteem and confidence.



## Treehouse Tales (oshl clubs)

We offer training on how to implement and lead this established literacy programme for children and their families, in partnership with Delyth Owen, founder and director of Treehouse Tales.
